Dear Madam, Sir,

I am pleased to invite you to participate in the Third Coordination Meeting relating to the GE06 Frequency Plan for Digital Terrestrial Television Broadcasting with the Arab region. This event, organized by the ITU in collaboration with the Arab Spectrum Management Group (ASMG) and at the kind invitation of the National Telecommunications Regulatory Agency (ANRT), Kingdom of Morocco, will be held in Marrakech, Morocco, from 13 to 16 April 2015.

Two Coordination Meetings of the GE06 Frequency Plan for Digital Terrestrial Television Broadcasting, intending to coordinate the transition to digital TV and initiate frequency coordination within the Arab States and between the Arab States and neighbouring countries with a view to facilitating harmonization and use of the digital dividend spectrum, already took place in:

- Dubai, United Arab Emirates, from 18 to 20 May 2014
- Hammamet, Tunisia, from 10 to 12 September 2014

As you are aware, the Coordination Meetings are focusing on re-evaluating the Frequency Plan adopted by the ITU Regional Radiocommunication Conference in 2006 (GE06 Plan) for terrestrial television broadcasting in the band 470-862 MHz and the necessary consequential actions.

This Third Coordination Meeting for Digital Terrestrial Television Service with the Arab region is intended to continue the frequency coordination between the ASMG administrations and their neighbouring countries. In order to facilitate discussions and coordination between administrations inside and outside the group of ASMG countries, your Administration is highly encouraged to participate in this meeting. In this context, the presence of administrations of countries neighbouring to ASMG countries is of great importance to the success of this meeting and will therefore be most welcome.
