**Abstract:** This liaison statements provides SG11 views on definition for broadband access

ITU-T SG11 management would like to thank SCV-CCV for incoming Liaison Statement [SCV - LS 13 -E](#). This LS was discussed by the SG11 meeting on 8-17 November 2017.

Following the discussion, SG11 notes that 2 Mbps is relatively low data rate relative to the speeds which can be provided with current various technologies. However, as the proposed definition is a minimum value, SG11 agrees with the proposed merged single definition for the term “broadband access”.
