Title: Meeting of the Collaboration on ITS Communication Standards (revised)

1 The ninth meeting of the Collaboration on ITS Communication Standards will take place on **12-13 October 2013** at Shiba-koen Denki Building in Tokyo, Japan, at the kind invitation of the Telecommunication Technology Committee (TTC).

2 The meeting coincides with related events taking place in Japan in the same period:

3 The intent of the Collaboration is to provide a globally recognized forum for the creation of an internationally accepted, globally harmonized set of Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) communication standards of the highest quality in the most expeditious manner possible to enable the rapid deployment of fully interoperable ITS communication-related products and services in the global marketplace.

5 Participation is open to: (1) Representatives of ITU Member States, Sector Members, Associates and Academia, and any individual from a country which is a member of ITU who wishes to contribute to the work; and (2) Any individual from a national, regional or international SDO who wishes to contribute to the work.

A draft agenda prepared by the Collaboration management and any contributions received will be made available on the webpage. Participants shall submit input documents in electronic format to ITU/TSB (tsbcits@itu.int).

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7 The meeting will open at **1300 hours on 12 October 2013 0900 hours on 13 October 2013**. Participant registration will begin at <u>1230-0830</u> hours in the TTC meeting room in Shiba-koen Denki Building.

No registration fee is required for participating in this meeting, but no fellowships will be granted. The discussions will be held in English only. Wireless LAN facilities are available for use by delegates at the venue.

10 **Remote Participation** is available for this meeting. As a remote delegate you will be able to hear discussions, see documents and presentations and interact with the remote meeting host. If you wish to participate as a remote delegate, you need to register in advance at <u>http://itu.int/en/ITU-T/extcoop/cits/</u>. Remote participation instructions will be made available to registered participants.

11 We would like to remind you that citizens of some countries are required to obtain a visa in order to enter and spend any time in Japan. The visa must be requested at least four (4) weeks before the date of beginning of the meeting and obtained from the office (embassy or consulate) representing Japan in your country or, if there is no such office in your country, from the one that is closest to the country of departure.



### 2. Transport

#### **From Narita Airport**

- By taxi: Print and take along <u>this</u> map to describe the location of TTC to the taxi driver. About JPY 21,950-22,130 plus highway toll, about 50min.
- By limousine bus:
  - (1) Narita Airport Shiba Park Hotel (take Narita Airport Shiba-Area Bus). JPY 3,000, about 90-145min, 6-8 services/day.
  - (2) Narita Airport Tokyo Station (take Narita Airport Tokyo Station and Nihonbashi Bus). JPY 3,000, about 75-110min, 2-3 services/hour.
  - (3) Narita Airport TCAT (Tokyo City Air Terminal) (take Narita Airport -TCAT Bus). JPY 2,900, about 60-90min, 3-6 services/day.
- By train:
  - (1) JR NaritaExpress (Narita Airport Tokyo) (Reservation Seat Only). JPY 2,940, about 60min, 2 services/hour.
  - (2) Keisei-Skyliner (Narita Airport Nippori) (Reservation Seat Only). JPY 2,400, about 36min, 1-2 services/hour.
  - (3) Keisei commuter train (Narita Airport Daimon). Take for Haneda Airport, Nishimagome, or Misakiguchi Train. JPY 1,100-1,280, about 80-90min, 2-3 services/hour.

#### **From Haneda Airport**

- By taxi: Use the map to describe the location of TTC to taxi driver. About JPY 6,290-6,380 plus highway toll, about 40min.
- By train/monorail:
  - (1) Tokyo Monorail (Haneda Airport International Building (Hamamatsucho), JPY 470, about 16min.
  - (2) Keikyu-Line (Haneda Airport International Terminal Daimon). Take train direct to Asakusa-Line (e.g. for Aoto, Inba-Nihonidai, Narita, or Narita-Airport train). JPY 510, about 20-30min.

#### From Tokyo Station

- By taxi (please use the map to describe the location of TTC to taxi driver) about JPY 1,250, about 20min.
- By train: JR Yamanote-Line or Keihin Tohoku-Line (Tokyo Hamamatsucho) direction Shinagawa, etc. JPY 150, about 6min.

#### **From Nippori Station**

- By taxi (please use the map to describe the location of TTC to taxi driver) about JPY 3,230, about 30min.
- By train: JR Yamanote-Line or Keihin Tohoku-Line (Nippori-Hamamatsucho) direction Tokyo, Shinagawa, etc. JPY 160, about 17min.

#### From TCAT

- By taxi (please use this map to describe the location of TTC to taxi driver) about JPY 1,790, about 20min.
- By subway: From Suitengumae Station (Z10) (Directly connected to TCAT) of Tokyo metro Hanzomon Line, direction Shibuya, etc. Exchange to (Toei) Mita Line at Otemachi Station (Z8/I9). Direction Mita, Hiyoshi, Megro, etc. Stop Station Onarimon (I6). JPY 260, about 19min.
