ANNEX 1 Practical information

Jeju/Korea

1. Location and Access

Jeju Island is an island off the southern coast of South Korea in the Korea Strait. The main town and capital is Jeju City (Jeju-si).

Delegates reach Jeju international airport (IATA: JCU; <u>http://www.airport.co.kr/mbs/jejueng/</u>) by direct or indirect flights (e.g., via Seoul's Incheon or Gimpo airports).

After arrival in airport, there are two ways to reach the meeting venue in Jeju-si; by bus or taxi. The distance from the airport to the venue is approximately 10 km and it takes about 35 minutes by bus (Number 500), or 20 minutes by taxi. The taxi transfer from Jeju International Airport to Jeju National University International Center costs approximately 6-7 US\$.
