Abstract: This document contains the announcement of the eighth FG-TBFXG meeting to be held in ETSI HQ (Sophia Antipolis, France) from 10 to 12 April 2024.

On behalf of Giulio Maggiore (FG-TBFXG Chair), we are pleased to announce that the eighth meeting of the **ITU-T Focus Group on Testbeds Federations for IMT-2020 and beyond (FG-TBFXG)** will be held in ETSI Headquarters (Sophia Antipolis, France) from **10 to 12 April 2024 at 1200-1600 hours local time (daily)**. The remote connection for FG-TBFXG meeting will be provided for registered participants who wish to join remotely. The FG-TBFXG will be collocated with ETSI TC INT meeting.

4. **Visa support:** the citizens of some countries are required to obtain a visa to enter and spend time in France. If required, visas must be requested before the date of arrival from the embassy or consulate representing France in your country or, if there is no such office in your country, from the one that is closest to the country of departure. Deadlines vary, so it is suggested to check directly with the appropriate representation and apply early.

8. **Participation rights:** Participation in the FG-TBFxG is free of charge and open to any individual from a country that is a member of ITU and who is willing to contribute actively to the work may participate in the focus group. The FG-TBFxG encourages collaboration with SDOs/Fora, Research Communities, Researchers on IMT-2020 and beyond, Industry Users of Testbeds, Testbeds Suppliers for IMT-2020 Testbeds and other Testbeds, CSPs (Communications Service Providers), Network Operators, Infrastructure Vendors/Suppliers for ICT and Verticals, Open Source & Open Hardware Projects, Regulators.

They need to be submitted to the TSB Secretariat (tsbfgtbf@itu.int) in electronic format using the templates available from the FG-TBFxG homepage (<https://itu.int/go/fgtbf>).
