## ADMISSION TO SOUTH AFRICA: DELEGATES ATTENDING HOSTING OF THE INTERNATIONAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS UNION (ITU-T) IPTV-GSI : 6 – 10 MAY 2013

In reply to your letter dated 11 February 2013, I wish to inform you that the South African Missions abroad have been authorized to issue visas to delegates attending the above event, provided a letter of invitation is submitted and that they are not prohibited or undesirable in terms of the Immigration Act, 2002, as amended.

To gain admission to South Africa it is necessary to be in possession of visas obtainable from South African Missions abroad, if the persons concerned are citizens of countries subject to visa control. All delegates' passports must be valid for at least 30 days beyond the intended date of departure from the RSA and should contain at least one unused visa pages when presenting the passport for purposes of endorsing a visa or a permit.

Immunisation for yellow fever is an entry requirement if the journey starts or entails passing through the yellow fever belt of Africa or South America.
