Considering the time zones of the various SG16 participants, the following session structure is proposed for the Virtual Meeting of SG16:

- *Session 0: 0830 – 0930 hours (Geneva time) – Early hours [ad hoc group use]*
- Session 1: 0930 – 1045 hours (Geneva time)
- Session 2: 1115 – 1230 hours (Geneva time)
- *Lunch break: 1230 – 1430 hours (Geneva time)*
- Session 3: 1430 – 1545 hours (Geneva time)
- Session 4: 1615 – 1730 hours (Geneva time)
- *Session 5: 1800 – 2000 hours (Geneva time) – After-hours [ad hoc group use]*

Guidance on meetings

- This is a **physical meeting with remote participation**. While participation in consensus-building will try to be as inclusive as possible, ultimately decisions are made by those physically present in the meeting room.
- As indicated in COL1/16, Remote participation will **not** be organized systematically for all sessions. **Requests** for remote participation must be received as soon as possible, but normally no later than **72 hours (3 days) ahead** of the planned session.
- Registration for ITU-T SG16 meeting is mandatory at <https://www.itu.int/go/tsg16/reg>. You will **not be able to join** if not registered **AND** approved by your organization's focal point for registration.
- In order to assist with effective remote participation, all sessions are expected to end on time. Rapporteurs are invited to finish their Question meetings on time to allow delegates to properly break and prepare for next session. Delegates joining remotely can join a session 30 minutes before its start, to ensure their working setup is properly configured.
