

Connect Summits aim at mobilizing human, financial, technical and political resources for the implementation of connectivity targets established at the World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS):

- Identify priority projects and project holders (in line with ITU Regional Initiatives)
- > Identify and engage potential partners
- Match partners and projects and establish Public-Private Partnerships
- Achieve political support at national and regional level
