#### Introduction

The first meeting of the CPM11 held in Geneva from 19 to 20 November 2007, decided on the establishment of Joint Task Group (JTG) 5-6 to deal with studies related to the use of the band 790-862 MHz by mobile applications and by other primary services, to ensure the adequate protection of services to which the band is allocated (WRC-11 Agenda item 1.17).

#### Visa requirements

The letter must be accompanied by a photocopy of your passport and completed registration form and must be sent by fax to the ITU-R Document and Meetings Unit, Office V.434, Attention: Mrs. L. Kocher. The fax number is +41 22 730 6600. Please note that the Union needs at least one week to process all papers required for the delivery of a visa.

Decision by the Conference Preparatory Meeting CPM11-1

#### Terms of reference of Joint Task Group 5-6

## Studies on the use of the band 790-862 MHz by mobile applications and by other primary services

The first session of the Conference Preparatory Meeting for WRC-11 (CPM11-1),

considering

- a) that WRC-07 recommended to include in the agenda of WRC-11 (Agenda item 1.17) to consider the results of sharing studies between the mobile service and other services in the band 790-862 MHz in Regions 1 and 3, in accordance with Resolution **749** [COM4/13] (WRC-07), to ensure the adequate protection of services to which the frequency band is allocated;
- b) that the band 790-862 MHz is currently allocated to the broadcasting, fixed, aeronautical radionavigation (No. 5.312) and mobile services on a primary basis;
- c) that No. 5.319 provides allocation in the band 790-862 MHz for mobile-satellite services on a secondary basis;
- d) that Resolution **749** [COM4/13] (WRC-07) calls for conducting sharing studies for Regions 1 and 3 in the band 790-862 MHz between the mobile service and other services in order to protect the services to which the frequency band is currently allocated;
- e) that the GE06 Agreement contains provisions for the terrestrial broadcasting service and other terrestrial services, a Plan for digital TV, and the List of other primary terrestrial services;
- f) that it is necessary to adequately protect, *inter alia*, terrestrial television broadcasting and other systems in this band;
- g) that CPM11-1 established a Joint Task Group (JTG 5-6) to deal with WRC-11 Agenda item 1.17.

decides that Joint Task Group 5-6 will

conduct sharing studies for Regions 1 and 3 in the band 790-862 MHz between the mobile service and other services in order to protect the services to which the frequency band is currently allocated,

further decides

- 1 that the organization of the work of JTG 5-6 will be carried out, insofar as possible, by correspondence, making maximum use of modern means of communication;
- that meetings of JTG 5-6 be scheduled with no overlap with regularly scheduled meetings of the relevant Working Parties of Study Groups 5 and 6, but may be scheduled at dates and locations near these Working Parties to facilitate participation by delegations;

- 3 that JTG 5-6 will not develop ITU-R Recommendations by itself. Any necessary Recommendations will be developed and adopted in the framework of either Study Group 5 or Study Group 6;
- 4 that JTG 5-6 will not need to liaise the results of its studies to the other Working Parties, but may required information, such as technical characteristics and interference objectives, from the concerned Working Parties;
- 5 that the work of JTG 5-6 will be completed according to the time schedule established by CPM11-1.
