Joint Task Group 5-6 Studies on the use of the band 790-862 MHz by mobile applications and by other services

Introduction

Visa requirements

We would remind you that citizens of some countries are required to obtain a visa in order to enter and spend any time in Switzerland. The visa must be requested and obtained from the office (embassy or consulate) representing Switzerland in your country or, if there is no such office in your country, from the one that is closest to the country of departure. If problems are encountered, the Union can, at the official request of the administration or company you represent, approach the competent Swiss authorities in order to facilitate delivery of the visa.

Visa requests should be made via an official covering letter from the administration or company you represent. This letter must specify your name and function, date of birth, passport number as well as the date of issuance and expiration. The letter must be accompanied by a photocopy of your passport and completed registration form and must be sent by fax to the ITU-R Document and Meetings Unit, Office V.434, Attention: Mrs. L. Kocher. The fax number is +41 22 730 6600. Please note that the Union needs at least one week to process all papers required for the delivery of a visa.

Participation

The intended participation of your representative(s) should be advised not later than one month before the opening of the meeting, by means of the annexed form (Annex 2) (to be photocopied as required). For hotel accommodation see <u>http://www.itu.int/travel/</u>.

Call for contributions

A number of issues have been raised during the first JTG 5-6 meeting (see Meeting Report above) that need consideration by administrations and subsequent submission of contributions to the next JTG 5-6 meeting, where considered appropriate (See Annexes 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 to Document 5-6/25). Areas urgently requiring contributions from the ITU-R membership in order to pursue further studies in the JTG 5-6 include:

- Submission of system characteristics, interference objectives and sharing methodologies.
- Review of the ITU-R texts that have been identified as being of potential use in the studies.
- Views on the work to be undertaken by the JTG 5-6 meetings with respect to the issue of adjacent channel interference.
- Contributions are also very much sought on the possibility that the approach implemented in the GE06 Agreement for the determination of the need to coordinate between administrations implementing different services in adjacent countries could be extended to cover cases concerning potential interference between countries which are not party to the GE06 Agreement¹ as well as to cases between countries party to the agreement and those which are not.

This list may not be exhaustive but it should provide a guide for the missing information relevant to Agenda item 1.17. The ITU-R membership is urged strongly to submit contributions to the next meeting of the JTG 5-6.
