

Biography



- Since then he has been working for the UAE Telecommunication Regulatory Authority, looking after the Regulatory and Policy Issues related to Media, Information and Communication Technologies at both National and International Levels.
- He has been effectively participating and contributing to the work and activities of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), in Geneva. Due to the nature of his work he has been greatly involved in many of the international negotiations and contributed to number of Telecom international policies and agreements. He has contributed and participated in over 200 International Conferences, Meetings, and Activities.
- In 2006 during the Regional Radio Communication Conference, Mr. Al Rashedi was selected as a Vice-Chairman for Regulatory Issues in the Conference, where he was greatly involved in developing the new Regional Agreement & Plan for Digital Broadcasting Switchover (GE-06 Agreement). In 2007, Naser Al-Rashedi was announced as the United Arab Emirates Administration Official Representative at the ITU. In same year he moderated the conference preparatory meeting with the cooperation of the African Telecommunication Union.
- During the World Radiocommunication Conference (WRC-07) he was selected as a Vice-Chairman to the Terrestrial Services Committee.
- Mr. Al Rashedi was selected also by the Conference Preparatory Meeting to be the Rapporteur of Chapter 3 (Mobile, Fixed, and Broadcasting Services) of the 2011 Conference Preparatory Meeting Report. He is also the Chairman of the Working Group on *Enhancing the International Regulatory Framework*, one of the most important agenda Items of next Radiocommunication Conference in 2011 (WRC-11).
- Naser Al Rashedi was selected as the Arab Regional Group Representative in many important matters and issues during the last years; such as World Telecommunication Development Resolution 9 where substantially contributed to the preparation of the Guidelines for Administrations on Developing Spectrum Fees Policy.
