History

Results of studies under WRC-12 AI 1.2 in accordance with Res. 951 (Rev. WRC-07) identified three main Issues:

- 1) Issue A: Convergence between Terrestrial services; mainly between Fixed and Mobile
→ NOC at WRC-12; studies to be completed and brought to the attention of WRC-15
- 2) Issue B: Convergence between Satellite Services; namely FSS, MSS, and BSS
→ NOC
- 3) Issue C: General Spectrum Allocation Principles (Famous WRC-REC. 34)
→ Updated

Why to review these definitions?

1

The current technological environment for some applications is substantively different from the one which prevailed when the current definitions were established.

2

Regulatory procedures should be continually assessed in order to meet the demands of administrations

3

review of the definitions should aim to support the implementation of efficient spectrum management practices and spectrum use

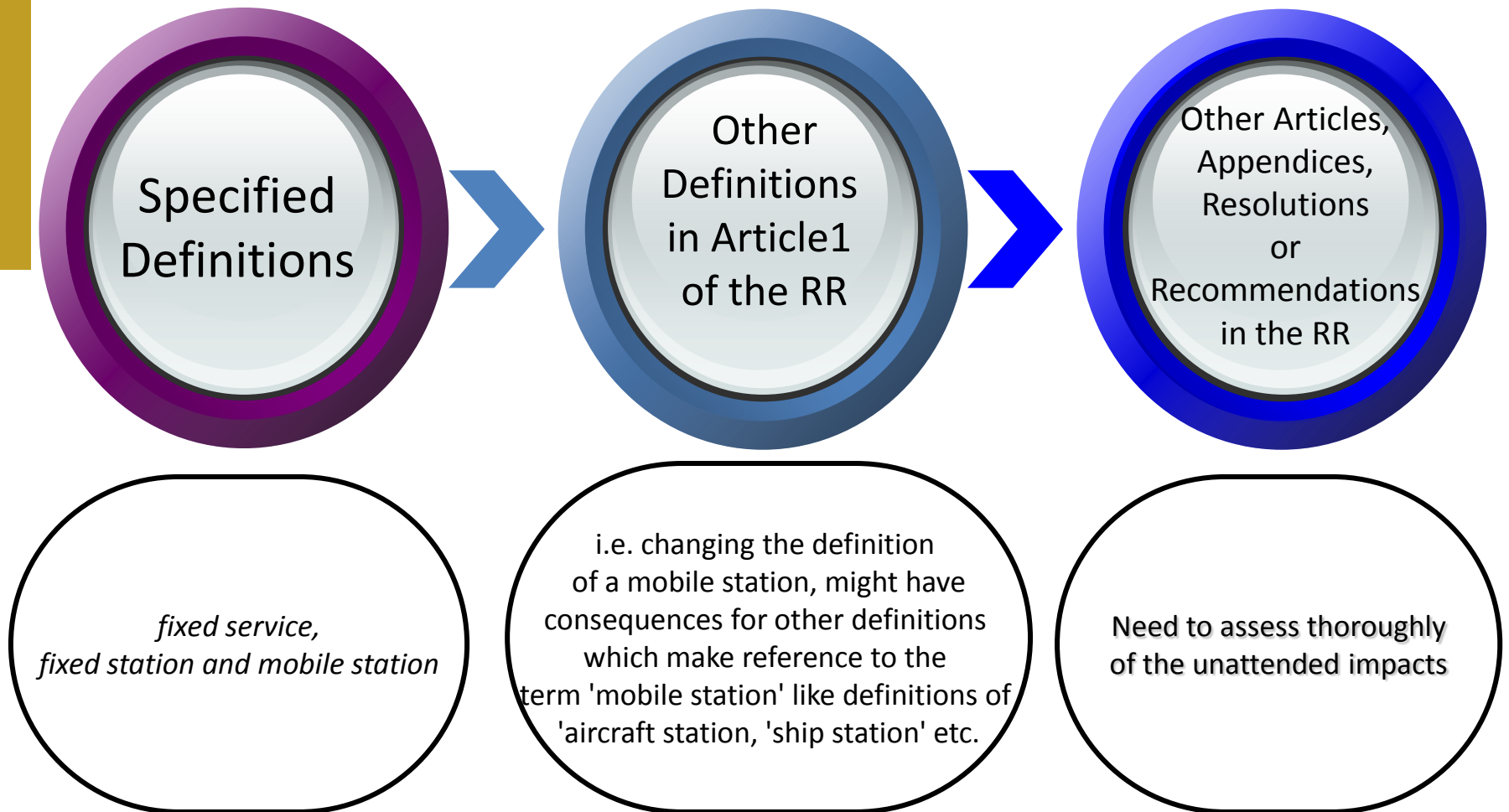
Resolution on Studies towards review of the definitions (WRC-15 A.I. 9.1.6 under General issues)

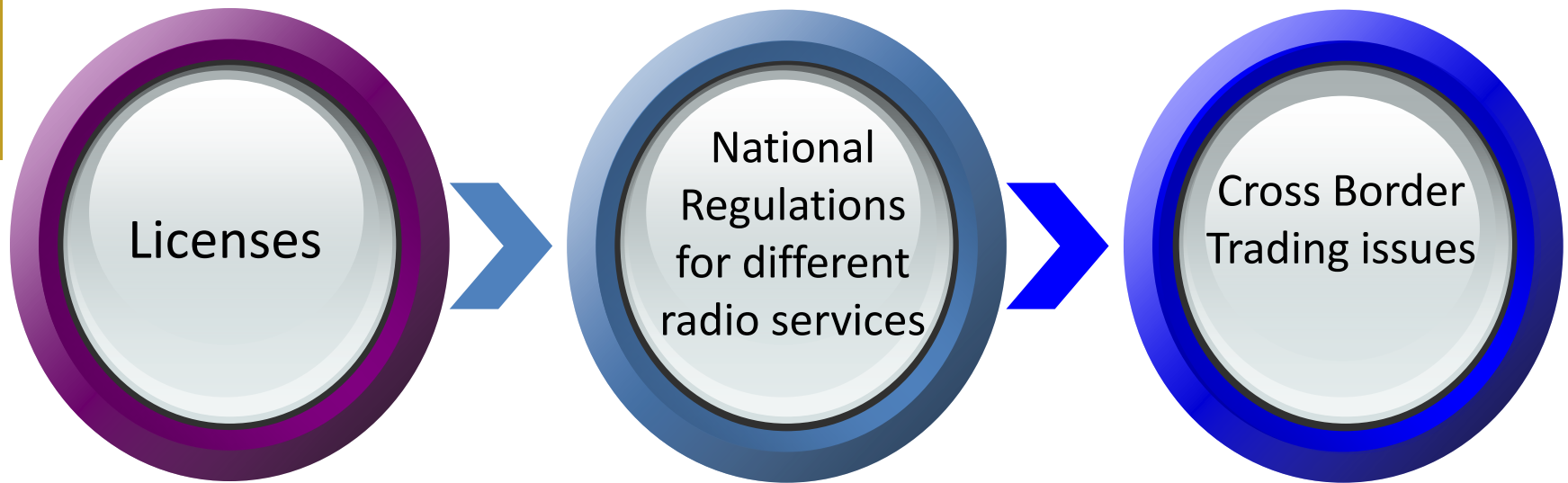
1 to review the definitions of *fixed service, fixed station* and *mobile station* contained in Article 1 for possible modification;

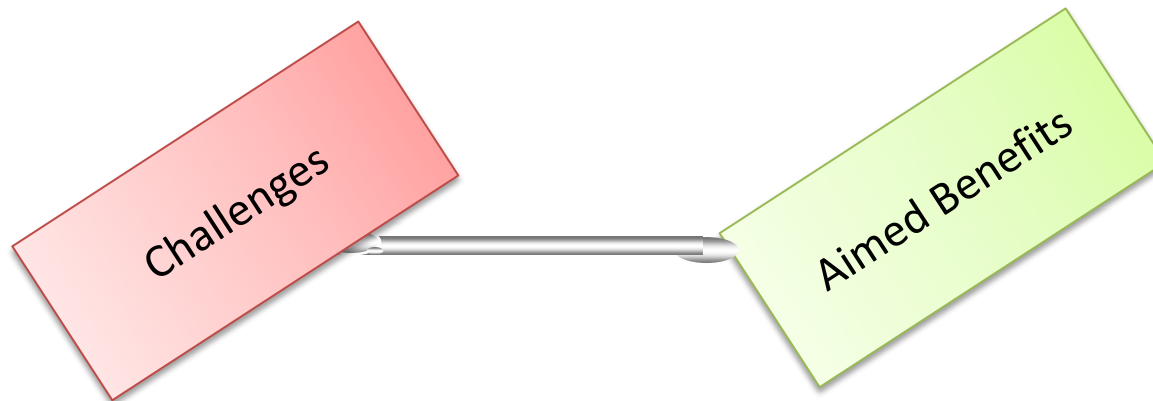
Impacts of review on Radio Regulations
