The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Cuba to the United Nations Office at Geneva and other International Organizations in Switzerland presents its compliments to the Chair of the ITU-WSIS+10 Working Group and has the honor of making reference to the WSIS+10 review process taking place within the framework of this body and specifically to the response given to our verbal note 219, dated 14 March 2014.

In this respect, this Permanent Mission profoundly regrets that your vision of the agreements taken during the third physical meeting on the mandate given to the Vice Chair is far from the understanding of this delegation and, in that regard, is obliged to reiterate that Cuba is not in a position to allow starting the next meeting on the basis of the new version of documents A, B and C, regarding the Preamble, Vision and Challenges. Without prejudging this position, the Cuban delegation transmits attached herewith new additional proposals to document C. This Mission also states that the original proposals of Cuba for parts A and B are completely valid for the next round of negotiations. For that reason, we will not repeat them, but we transparently inform that we will work on them during the fourth physical meeting.
