
Session's link to Sustainable Development Process

Brief on eKrishok

Bangladesh Institute of ICT in Development (BIID) introduced eKrishok (Electronic Farmer) in 2009 as an ICT enabled solution to facilitate extension services to the farmers and business development services to the agro-businesses, primarily to the micro, small and medium (MSME). BIID considers *Farmer is an entrepreneur and farming is Business*. Based on this principle, a service basket designed for ekrishok ranging from information to market linkage, business planning to profitability calculator. These services address the access to information challenge exists in the existing eco-system and enable target groups to avail the services by using mobile phone and internet. eKrishok has been recognized by FAO, ITU, CTA and Government of Bangladesh as one of the most innovative and sustainable eAgriculture initiative.
