


3. EMPODERA Awards




5. #EmpoderArte: The Exhibition

"You are the Artist, show us in a picture what is technology for you" (http://empoderarte.org/). EmpoderArte is a collaborative Photograph exhibition made by hundreds of pictures shared by citizens in Social Netwoerks. This project involves actively citizenship about how the ICT improve their life, of how the citizens feel the technology, throught their pictures.

#EmpoderArte is a collaborative exhibition with the goal of thinking about technology as a means for generating social innovation and citizen empowerment. Through this open call each person becomes an artist and at the same time becomes a real example of the concept of citizen empowerment with his/her participation. The participants share their pictures in different social networks and after that the pictures was exhibited in a big art wall at the Projects room in the Malaga Contemporary Art Center (CACMalaga), creating a living exhibition made by citizen participation that was exhibited from June 25 to July 7 2013.





EmpoderArte is a collaborative art exhibition open to public participation about Social Innovation and connected to the citizen through dozens of photographs and videos. Because a picture is worth a thousand words, we want all the citizens to participate so they can see what are we talking about...
