The ITU World Telecommunication/ICT Development Report (WTDR) 2010  
focuses on  
**Monitoring the WSIS Targets**

Half way through the timeline for the achievement of the 10 targets that governments agreed upon at the World Summit on the Information Society, the report:

- Reviews the 10 targets, which range from connecting villages, schools and health centres to developing content, and providing people with ICT access
- Provides policy-makers with an assessment of progress made to date
- Proposes concrete indicators to monitor the targets
- Makes recommendations on policies and measures to help achieve the targets by 2015

The report reflects a joint effort among several international organizations, led by ITU, with contributions from UNESCO, WHO and UNDESA, as well as from representatives of civil society.
