The Council,

Resolution 77 of the Kyoto Plenipotentiary Conference on future conferences of the Union, pursuant to paragraph 1.6 of which the World Telecommunication Development Conference (WTDC-02) is to be held during the first quarter of 2002,

welcoming

the invitation of the Government of Turkey,

resolves

- that the World Telecommunication Development Conference (WTDC-02) shall be convened in Istanbul (Turkey) for a duration of 10 days from 18-27 March 2002;
- to appeal to the participants of the World Telecommunication Development Conference (WTDC-02) to make a special emphasis on the problem of "bridging **the digital divide"**;
- to adopt the draft agenda contained in Annex A subject to the consultation of the Member States of the Union in application of No. 213 of the Convention of the ITU,

to prepare draft guidelines for the preparation of WTDC-02 and to annex them to the invitation to attend the Conference,

instructs the Secretary General
