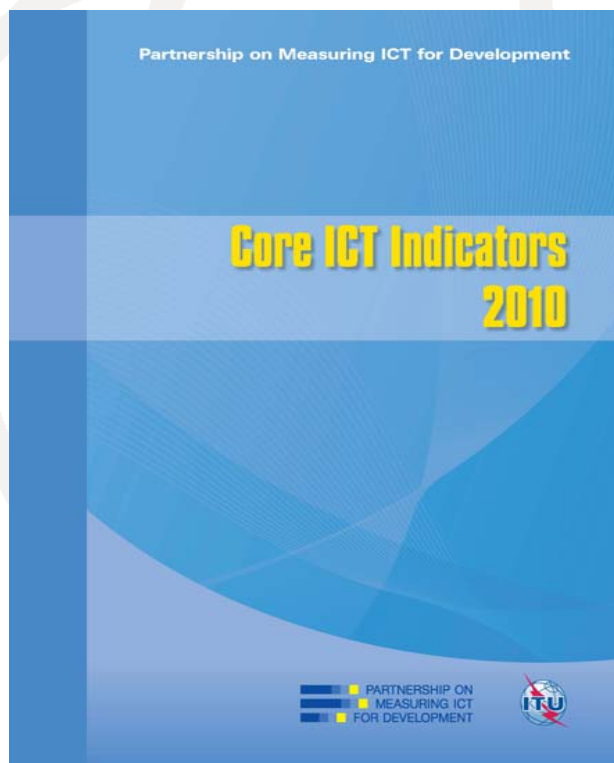

# Core list of ICT indicators

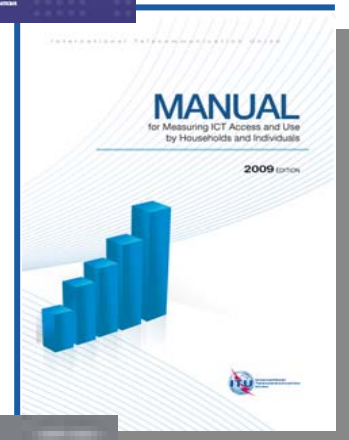
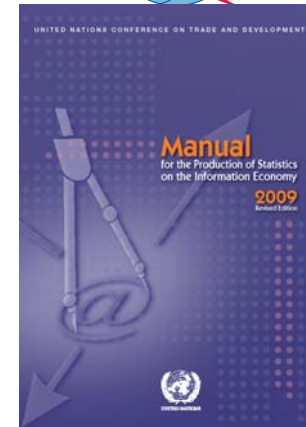


- Endorsed by UN Statistical Commission in 2007
- **Launched during the UN Statistics Commission, New York, February 2010**
- Revised and extended list
- Definitions, statistical standards, classifications, model survey questions
- Covering: ICT infrastructure, ICT in households, ICT in businesses, ICT sector and trade, ICT in education
- Currently available in English and French (other languages to be available soon)

## World Telecommunication/ICT Development Report 2010



- **Monitoring the WSIS Targets: A mid-term review**
- Reflects joint effort among several international organisations: ITU, UNESCO, WHO and UNDESA, as well as from representatives of civil society
- Proposes concrete indicators to monitor targets
- Makes recommendations on policies and measures to help achieve the targets

## Task Group: WSIS Targets

### Activities/outputs

- Develop a framework for monitoring the WSIS targets
- Prepare a document including the final set of indicators and their definitions, benchmarks and collection methodologies
- Disseminate the list of WSIS indicators to stakeholders
- Present and discuss the monitoring framework at relevant global and regional events
- Compile data on a continuous basis
- Prepare a final report for WSIS 2015, making a global assessment of progress achieved in reaching the goals.
