## 8 - 9 July 2010

The Workshop on "Experience of testing and introduction of NGN" under the joint ITU-ZNIIS project "International Telecommunication Testing Centre (ITTC)" was held in ZNIIS head-quarter (Moscow)

This workshop is a continuation of activities carried out in a joint project of ITU-ZNIIS whose purpose is to disseminate knowledge and results of the ITTC experts work for testing systems-network solutions, equipment and communications services among professionals of developing countries and countries of the CIS region, members of the RCC (Regional Commonwealth in the field of communications).

The Workshop opened topical at present aspects of testing is widely used technologies, including experience of international companies - manufacturers and telecom operators.

The program of the Workshop included:

- Testing of perspective technologies (IPTV, Femto-cell etc.);
- Experience of access networks equipment testing based on PON technologies;
- Aspects of granting required QoS parameters in NGN networks;
- Experience of NGN introduction in the countries of the CIS region (RCC);
- Virtual Laboratory as the instrument of remote testing and practical training of the specialists in the field of telecommunications

During the presentation of the results of the project **director of Technopark Denis Andreev** said that ITCC activities directly aimed at ensuring the **WTSA Resolution 76, ITTC Model Network** can be used as one of the sites to test for conformance and interoperability within **«ITU Mark» program**.

In June 2010 there was the official opening of the ITU database for testing for conformance, which will also be reflected with ITTC test results.





The Workshop was attended by representatives from the following countries: Belarus, Kazakhstan, Moldova, Kyrgyzstan, Uzbekistan and Russia.

As part of ongoing discussions, the participants supported the ITTC work on testing and have shown considerable interest in the new project to establish on the base of ITTC Virtual Laboratory.
