- Public Consultation no 65, from 27/7/98
 - Procedures to be followed during the Digital TV tests
- Resolution no 69, from 23/11/98
 - Approval of the Procedures to be followed during the Digital TV tests
- Public Consultation no 216, from 17/2/ 2000
 - 1st Part of the final SET/ABERT Report on tests carried out with the ATSC, DVB and ISDB digital television standards
 - This report concludes, considering only the technical aspects, which is the best modulation scheme.



Description of the Main Resolutions and Public Consultations

- Public Consultation no 229, from 7/4/2000
 - 3rd Intermediary SET/ABERT Report
- Public Consultation no 237, from 2/7/2000
 - 2nd Part of the final SET/ABERT Report on tests carried out with the ATSC, DVB and ISDB digital television standards;
 - This report concludes, considering only the technical aspects, which is the best digital television standard.



Key Aspects Related to the Evolution of the Television Broadcasting Service

- Screen Format
- Interactivity
- Mobility
- Television and Personal Computer Convergence
- Telecommunication and Television Convergence



Factors to be taken into Consideration: Technical

Technical factors:

- The digital television service must be, at least, equivalent to the currently distributed analogue television service
- Digital and analogue systems must have an adequate coexistence during the transition period
- Power consumption must be economical
- Flexibility for introduction of new applications must be taken into account in the long-run

Digital Broadcasting x Pay TV

- The digital television service offered these different networks must be compatible
- The integration of programs and functionality between these different networks must be considered
- Must carry rules should be duly applied



Factors to be taken into Consideration: Strategic

- Universal access to information for all social classes
- National integration and the preservation of the regional identity
- Latin American integration
- Technological co-operation
- Rapid economic development
- Rebirth of the parts and components industry



Factors to be taken into Consideration: Economic

- Impact on the Broadcasting Industry Value Chain
- Determinant factors for the promotion of the digital television
- Cost to the Broadcasters
- Cost to the Consumers
- Potential market of each digital television system



Factors to be taken into Consideration: Social and Cultural

- The role played by the television in the life of the citizens
- The convergence from the cultural point of view
- Expectations of the users on the digital television
- Others cultural and socials factors

 - Scenario IIa Multiples programs
 - Scenario IIb SDTV interactive
 - Scenario IIc SDTV with free and paid services
- Scenario III Hybrid model
