Mr. Rajendra Singh graduated in Electronics and Communication Engineering from the IIT Roorkee. He did his Master of Technology from IIT Delhi and MBA from FMS, University of Delhi. He worked for Indian Railways for about 18 years and was responsible for planning, installation and commissioning of various telecommunication projects on Indian Railways. He has published around 15 technical papers in international journals and conferences. He is, for the last five years, working on deputation with Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) as Advisor (Mobile Network). In TRAI, he is responsible for all regulatory issues of cellular mobile services, Unified Licensing, spectrum management and rural telecommunications. He is also responsible for the issues related to USO in TRAI and is a Member of Inter-Ministerial Advisory Committee for Universal Service Fund Administration.
