- ? Unlicensed doesn't mean unregulated
- ? More complex power limit metrics required
- ? Cross-country type approvals

Encouraging entrepreneurship

- ? Radical simplification of business licensing

- ? Limit natural monopolies to physical infrastructures – don't let them own anything above Layer-1
