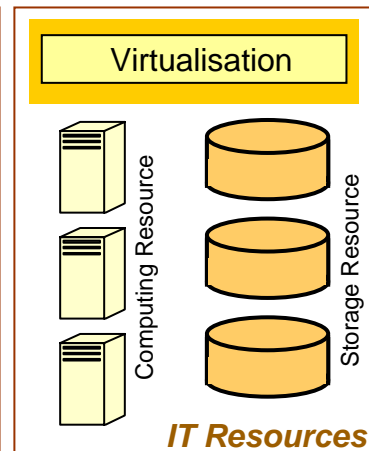
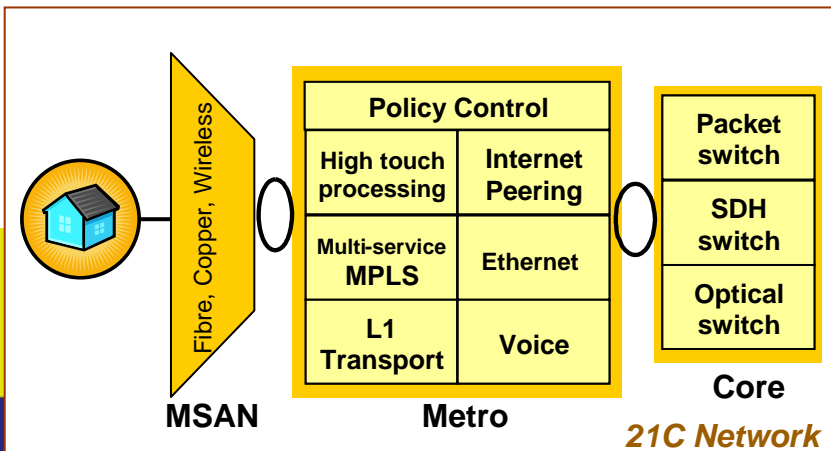
# 21CN Converged Architecture

# Cornerstones of the NGN

- Separation of Applications, Service Control and Transport
- Business models enabling core and access providers
- Basic mobility (nomadism built on personal identity) with the promise of full mobility
- Taking services forward into the multimedia experience
- A flexible and adaptable Platform for delivery of voice, advanced multimedia and innovative new services

# ITU-T is moving into the whole sphere of ICT

- ITU is standardising:
  - NGN, IPTV, RFID, OCAF, ...
- But must work with an increasing number of bodies:
  - ETSI TISPAN, ATIS, 3GPP, TMF, DSL-Forum, DVB, IPsphere, MEF, Liberty Alliance, ...
