- Mr. Andrea Macchioni (Ministry of Communications), Vice-Chairman of TSAG, to be confirmed;
- Mr. Gastone Bonaventura (Telecom Italia), Vice-Chairman of Study Group 15, to be confirmed;
- Mr Kiritkumar Latia (Siemens Mobile Communication), Vice Chairman of SSG, to be confirmed.

Eventually I point out that Italy is ready to propose other possible candidates in addition to the above, if useful for the ITU-T.

In any case I'd like to draw your attention on the fact that Mr. Macchioni is the only candidate of the Ministry of Communications, whom the Italian Administration count on.

I'll send you by e.mail the CV of the proposed candidates within few days.
