This includes additional gaps that may need to be documented.
- (3) Derive and document requirements to address the gaps discussed in the Draft Use Case Gap Analysis Report.
- (4) Start the work to develop and document a global IdM framework to harmonize, bridge and interoperate IdM solutions and specifications.
