ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC27 held a meeting on Cloud Computing Security and Privacy (22 April 2013) to (i) update attendees on the status of the activities that are currently taking place in the area of Cloud Computing Security and Privacy within SC27 and in other Sub-Committees and Liaison Organisations, and (ii) identify any issues and topics for further consideration.

On 22 April 2013 a joint Cloud Security and Privacy editors meeting was held to specifically review the topic of terminology and definitions. During this meeting it was agreed that SC27 editors would mutually share with SC 38 what was being used and applied in SC 27 Projects in order to have a consistent and compatible use of terms in Cloud standards.

WG 5 on the project ISO/IEC 27018

ISO/IEC SC 38

It was requested that at the next ISO/IEC SC 27 meeting a Special Session on Cloud Computing be held similar to the one in Rome 2012.

It was requested that the SP Rapporteurs create a summary document that contains a graphical representation of all the cloud computing related projects across SC27 and be made available as a standing document.

It was suggested that the Study Period coordination activity continue in a formalized activity of ISO/IEC SC27.
