


## **Results of the application of the U4SSC initiative in Pully**





- In 2017 Pully launched the project to measure KPIs according to the methodology of the U4SSC initiative led by the ITU, UNECE and 15 UN agencies.
- The result of the application of U4SSC initiative is a 2-meter high Excel chart with around 1000 cells.
- An other result is the U4SSC certificate awarded by ITU and UNECE the 26th of April 2018



- The first one was collecting the target values.
- In fact, the U4SSC initiative can be considered an excellent thermometer.
- However, for a thermometer to be truly effective, it is necessary to know that a fever starts at 37 degrees ©.


## Two challenges:

2 – Make it easily usable






- Here are the politicians who represent the city of Pully.
- However, the question remained: "How will they be able to use this two-meter high chart to communicate with the citizens, companies, administrations, other cities, regional and national governments?"
- Therefore we launched a Phase 2 project which consists of developping an intuitive and user-friendly representation of the data, which aims to be as comprehensive as possible.



- Here we have all the KPIs which belong to the category «Water and sanitation»
- For each KPI we choose to represent it with a pictogram. In so doing, the reader has a visual intuitive idea.
- We add the official name, according to the U4SSC initiative, the level of achievement, and some metadatas
- Thereafter, a text summarizing the situation in Pully according to the results of the KPIs
- Finally, examples of actions taken by the Municipality are indicated.

- Limited number of indicators
- International norm: ITU-T Y.4903/L1603
- ICT used as a tool to contribute to reaching SDGs



- Opportunity for politicians to step back and observe the big picture
- To outline the middle and long terms trends
- Internal and external communication tool for the city
- Potential to exchange ideas and resources between cities



- Concerning the strengths we can highlight two levels
- Regarding the U4SSC methodology: Klick
- The global overview of the city Pully
- The limited number of indicators which favor a rapid collection of the indicators
- The international norm which offers a common reference to cities worldwide
- Give a sense of usefullness to ICTs in order to contribute to reaching SDGs
- Regarding the city of Pully, it offers:
- An opportunity for politicians to observe the big picture
- To outline the middle and long term trends
- To provide material for the future «Legislative program»
- Internal and external communication tool for the city
- To increase the potential to exchange ideas and resources between cities

## **Potential for improvement**



- Difficulty to take into account local specificities
- To add some specific indicators
- Update the KPIs every 5 years



- Two following potentials for improvement could be adressed: Klick
- Difficulty to take into account local specificities
- To add indicators linked to data protection, cybersecurity, citizen relationship with police, economic situation, etc.
- Update KPIs every 5 years


# New report «Pully under the microscope 2024»



Work in progess




- Pully has decided to launch the update of the U4SSC KPIs collecting every 5 years
- That's why we are now working on this update with the objective to publish a new report «Pully under the microscope 2024»
- This is also an opportunity to adress the potential improvements



- National KPIs and local KPIs will be added to global KPIs measured by the U4SSC initiative
- Like that we will have three different scales measured
- The world
- Switzerland
- The city

## «Cercle indicateurs» initiative Developped by Swiss cities and Cantons with 32 KPIs

#### Some examples:

- Environnement: nesting birds
- Economy: tax burden of individuals
- Society: social assistance rate



- A the national level we rejoined the Cercle indicateurs initiative wich is piloted by the Swiss Confederation with the collaboration of the Cantons and the Cities
- This will add 32 KPIs, for example:
  - Environment: nesting birds which reflect the quality of the biodiversity
  - Economy: tax burden of individuals
  - Society : social assistance rate


#### Local KPIs choosen by city departements

#### Some examples:

- Environnement: State of separation of the water drainage systems
- Economy: Annual investment to maintain infrastructure value
- Society: Training of employees in cybersecurity



- At the local level, the departments of Pully will suggest around 30 KPIs, for example:
  - Environnement : State of separation of the water drainage systems between rainwater and wastewater
  - Economy: Annual investment to maintain infrastructure value
  - Society: Gender pay equity or training of employees in cybersecurity



- How might we practically integrate U4SSC KPIs as a policy management tool?
   Here is the
- In Pully after the elections, the elected members of the Municipality published a Policy Program named "Programme de legislature 2021-2026" which describes the projects they want to achieve
- To pilot and realize thoses projects, a new "Project management competence center" was developed with:
  - Project management methodology harmonized for all departments of the city
  - A projects portefolio, currently there are 185 projects in progress
  - A scorecard that measures progress in achieving the objectives of the legislative program with a mid-year review
- Every 5 years the global, national and local KPIs are updated and give the big picture to the Municipality. This will help to define the next Policy program 2026-2031



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 So I hope, I've managed to highlight the experience of a small city focused on the use of KPI's, the elaboration of the report as a communication tool, and the way to make it a tool for policy management. I look forward to sharing innovative ideas with you and perhaps, with the help of the U4SSC initiative, co-create a project together in the future.
