I am also pleased to inform you that **Partial Fellowships** will be awarded based on available funding to facilitate participation from Least Developed Countries (LDC) or Low Income Developing Countries (LIC) to the Training Course. Application for Fellowship, limited to one person per country, must be authorized by the relevant Administration of the ITU Member State. The Fellowship Request Form should be returned to ITU not later than **15 March 2015**.
