Other sessions of WTIS-2015 will focus on pertinent topics such as big data from the ICT sector and the data revolution, measuring the impact of ICT, ICT indicators and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) monitoring framework. The results of the work of the Expert Group on Telecommunication/ICT Indicators (EGTI) and the Expert Group on Household indicators (EGH) will also be presented for adoption by WTIS-2015.
