## Subject: ITU Centres of Excellence face-to-face training on "Teletraffic Engineering for the Internet – Analytical Approach", Warsaw, Poland, 24-25 November 2016

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am pleased to invite your organization to participate in the face-to-face training on **"Teletraffic Engineering for the Internet – analytical approach"** to be held in **Warsaw, Poland** from **24 to 25 November 2016**. This training is organized jointly by the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) and the National Institute of Telecommunications (NIT) as part of the Capacity Building in Internet Governance programme under the auspices of the ITU Centres of Excellence for Europe. The training will be delivered in English.

The training will aim to introduce to participants the idea of modeling systems to which IP traffic is offered. The basic notions associated with traffic engineering and modeling of network systems within the context of QoS parameters will be discussed. Models of traffic for IP systems will be also presented. The course will also consider the modeling of a single-service system. Therefore, the basic models of full-availability systems will be presented, including Erlang, Engset, Pascal and Hayword models.
