**Kiev** is the capital city of Ukraine, a hero city. It is the largest city of Ukraine, as well as its cultural, political, social and economic, transport, scientific and religious centre. Also, Kiev is the seventh largest city of Europe by population after Moscow, Istanbul, London, Saint Petersburg, Berlin, and Madrid: density of the population in Kiev is 3,433 per km². Kiev occupies a territory of 847 km². It lies on the river of Dnepr, in the north of central area of the country, and is a separate administrative and territorial unit of Ukraine. The city consists of 10 districts located on right and left riversides.

#### 10. Climate

Kiev has a moderately continental climate. In November, the average daily temperature is + 2° C, the average night temperature is -2° C.

#### 11. Time

Kiev time (winter) - UTC / GMT + 2:00.

#### 12. Electrical devices

Voltage power in Ukraine - 220V / 50 Hz.

#### 13. Communication means

The venue of the workshop, participants will be wireless Internet access.
