I am pleased to inform you that the United States Telecommunications Training Institute (USTTI) and the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) will continue their joint fellowship programme, offering assistance to developing countries to participate in selected training courses organized by USTTI in the United States. The fellowships are intended to finance subsistence costs for the duration of training. USTTI will waive the tuition fees for ITU fellows. The cost of international airfares and domestic travel in the United States is to be borne by the home Administration of the participant.

17-245 - Mobile Broadband: Empowering People, Business and Society - 21-23 August

17-330 - Radio Spectrum Monitoring Techniques and Procedures - 25-29 September

17-331 – Laboratory Techniques in Support of Equipment Authorization Programs – 2-6 October

17-260 – Internet Policymaking in a Multistakeholder Environment – 21-25 October 2017

The selection of courses reflects the priority areas defined by the ITU membership and complements the capacity building activities undertaken by ITU. In this context, I invite you to take advantage of the wide range of courses offered through the ITU Academy, available at https://academy.itu.int/.

Administrations are invited to apply by using the attached fellowship nomination form at least four weeks before the proposed starting date. Administrations whose candidates have been accepted for training will be informed in due course.
