I am pleased to inform you that the Telecommunication Development Bureau (BDT) of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), in collaboration with the Swiss Webacademy, and in partnership with Romanian Regulatory Authority (ANCOM), the National Romanian Police, the Romania National CERT, the Romanian Intelligence Services as well as the Swiss Canton of Geneva, and Poste Italiane CERT is supporting the 5<sup>th</sup> Central European Cybersecurity Public-Private Dialogue Platform to be held from 14 to 15 September 2017 in Sibiu, Romania.
