Dear Sir/Madam,

I would like to thank all those Members that connected to the two TDAG meetings that took place in early June for their participation. Figures were record-breaking: 383 participants for the first meeting on 2-5 June, and 168 participants for the second one on 16 June.

Despite this being the first fully virtual TDAG meetings, discussions flowed and were fruitful, thanks to the very able steering by the Chairperson, to the patience and discipline of all participants, and to the backstage support of our hardworking ITU staff. Reports on the conclusions of the two meetings are available as follows:

Registration, access and participation

Delegates can register to the meeting using their ITU user account credentials (i.e. username and password), old TIES accounts are also valid. Potential delegates who do not have an ITU user account can create one by following the steps available at: <https://www.itu.int/en/ties-services/>.

Note: For delegates who created a user account when registering for the previous TDAG meeting, their user account is still valid.

All registration requests for participation in the TDAG WG meetings must be **validated by the Designated Focal Points (DFPs)** of administrations and entities entitled to participate.
