Subject: Invitation to participate in and contribute to Generation Connect Global Youth Summit 2022

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am pleased to invite you to the first Generation Connect Global Youth Summit 2022 in Kigali, Rwanda, from 2 to 4 June 2022, preceding the World Telecommunication Development Conference (WTDC) under the WTDC's theme "Connecting the unconnected to achieve sustainable development".

The <u>Generation Connect Global Youth Summit</u> will focus on meaningful youth engagement, consultations, collaboration, empowerment, participation and calls for action, aimed at bringing the voices of young people into WTDC.

Young people will debate and brainstorm on how technologies can be harnessed to advance progress towards the SDGs and propose, with their unique cultural and personal perspectives and experiences, how the power of technology can change the world – build, back, better!

The Generation Connect Global Youth Summit will be in a hybrid format, combining physical and virtual participation. Youth aged 18-29 are invited to participate physically and youth aged 15-29 may participate virtually.

I also invite you to sponsor the Generation Connect Global Youth Summit (Sponsorship package annexed) as well as partner with us, in the different activities that will take place during the Summit itself. Sponsorship will be on a first come first served basis.

As digital natives and future leaders, we engaged with young people to co-design the Summit draft program by youth, for youth.

Through thoughtful consultation, youth have emphasized their desire to meaningfully engage and participate in a variety of activities aligned with the theme of the Summit, including capacity building sessions, intergenerational dialogues, mentorship and networking opportunities, debates for youth by youth, and the creation of a "Call to action on our digital future" document.

These activities aim to amplify young voices in the digital development dialogue at a global level, an essential step towards the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and a more inclusive digital future (the draft program annexed). The outcome will be presented to the WTDC.

As we approach this exciting first edition of the Generation Connect Global Youth Summit, we invite you to bring your young leaders. We welcome young entrepreneurs, social change-makers and promising young people from your administration, company and/or university (open call document annexed).

We hope every ITU Member and region is represented, to help create an international movement of passionate youth advocates of change, who are using technology and ICTs to shape our future.

Youth from all over the world will be invited to participate physically in Kigali and virtually, through the Generation Connect platform, as well as the setup of Summit hubs in each region.
