On behalf of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), I am pleased to invite you to ITU Regional Workshop for Europe and CIS on *Cybersecurity and Child Online Protection*, which is organized by the Telecommunication Development Bureau (BDT) of the ITU in collaboration with the A.S.Popov Odessa National Academy of Telecommunications (ONAT) of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine and will be held in Odessa, Ukraine, from 4 to 6 April 2018.

This Workshop is addressed to representatives of ministries, regulators, telecommunication operators, universities and general education institutions, telecommunication equipment manufacturers, research and design institutes, software developers and other interested stakeholders of the ITU Member States, Sector Members and Associates from Europe and CIS Regions.

9. General information

Odessa is a city on the Black Sea coast of Ukraine, the administrative center of the Odessa region, the largest port of Ukraine, a major industrial, cultural, scientific and resort center, highways and railways node.

Odessa is the third city in the country in terms of population. The city is situated on the Odessa Bay of the Black Sea. The most part of the city, including the historical center, is located on the plains overtopping the sea level about 50 m. The area of the city is 163 km², population density is 6139 persons/ km². Odessa is characterized by the developed highways network. The city is located near Danube, Dnestr, Southern Bug, and Dnepr rivers, which along with the large seaports of Odessa, Illychevsk and Yuzhny and Odessa international airport and railway form the unique favorable conditions for loads accepting, processing, saving and transporting and the powerful passenger flows processing.

10. Climate

The climate of Odessa is temperate continental. In April, the average daily temperature is +13° C, the average nighttime temperature is +8° C.

11. Time

Kiev time (summer) - UTC / GMT + 3:00.

12. Electric devices

Voltage power in Ukraine - 220V / 50 Hz.

13. Communication means

In the event venue, participants will be provided with wireless Internet access.

For calls to Odessa, dial the code is + 380 48.

For international calls from Odessa, one should dial plus, then the country code, area code (when calling from a mobile phone) or follow the instructions on the phone card.

14. Visa
