I am pleased to invite your organization to participate in the **Young ICT Leaders' Forum and YILF Challenge 2018** that will take place **from 4 – 7 September 2018** in Busan City, Republic of Korea. Both events are jointly organized and hosted by Busan Metropolitan City.

The Forum aims to promote an active participation of youth in the digital economy, including (1) promoting the engagement of youth in the field of ICTs; (2) decreasing the digital divide; and (3) promoting research on emerging ICTs particularly Internet of Things (IoT).

The Young ICT Leaders' Forum 2018 also incorporates "**YILF Challenge 2018**" which is an open competition platform for young people to present their **ideas to solve issues facing smart cities' ecosystems**. Enabling a good ecosystem is essential to the development of digital technologies making a city smarter, safer, and friendlier to the environment, thereby improving the quality of life of the citizens. **Annex 1** contains the tentative programme of this event. The event will be conducted in English.

Busan Metropolitan City will provide fellowships (including round-trip air ticket and hotel accommodation) to qualified YILF Challenge applicants, subject to available budget. The approved fellows will participate in the Forum component, and will be trained and coached in developing smart city ecosystem strengthening projects based on their submissions. The last date for receiving applications is **28 July 2018**. Early submissions are preferred. I shall appreciate your kind circulation of this invitation among local stakeholders, youth, entrepreneurs, ecosystem enablers, and startups in your country.
