# Information note for participants

## Registration

Advance registration is mandatory, following these steps:

- <u>Create an ITU user account</u> (if you already have an account, go to step 2): When creating an ITU user account affiliated to an ITU Member (<u>Member States</u>, <u>Sector Members</u>, <u>Associates</u>, <u>Academia</u>, and UN System), users must obtain approval of their affiliation from the corresponding TIES Focal Point prior to submitting a registration request.
- 2. <u>Register here</u>: Log in with your ITU user account credentials and complete the corresponding registration request form. After successful submission, you will receive an acknowledgement of successful submission of the registration request.
- 3. Your registration request is automatically forwarded to the corresponding <u>Designated Focal Points</u> (<u>DFPs</u>) for ITU-D event registration.
- 4. Upon the approval of the DFP, you will receive a confirmation of registration email.
