I am pleased to invite you to participate in the 2025 Global Symposium for Regulators (GSR-25) under the theme: ***Regulation for sustainable digital development***. GSR-25 will be organized by the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), in collaboration with the Government of Saudi Arabia. The event will be held from 31 August to 3 September 2025 at the King Abdul Aziz International Conference Center, Riyadh, Saudi Arabia and will be chaired by His Excellency Dr Mohammed Saud Al-Tamimi, Governor of the Communications, Space & Technology Commission (CST).

Built around interactive high-level panels on topical and cutting-edge policy and regulatory issues, GSR-25 provides regulators and policy makers from around the world with a unique platform for discussions among peers and with other digital stakeholders. As part of GSR-25 pre-events, a regulatory masterclass will be held on 31 August, and the Executive Heads of Regulators' Roundtable (upon invitation only), the Regional Regulatory Associations (RA)/Digital Regulation Network meeting, and the Industry Advisory Group on Development Issues and Private Sector Chief Regulatory Officers' (IAGDI-CRO) meeting on 1 September. Core sessions of GSR-25 will be held from 1 September in the afternoon until 3 September.

The proposed topics for the discussions consider suggestions by the membership following GSR-24. Focusing on various aspects of regulation for digital development, the sessions will address the following themes: collaborate, connect, trust, protect, include, empower, sustain and innovate.
