Dear Sir/Madam,

I am pleased to invite you to participate in the <u>Regional Development Forum for Americas</u> (RDF-AMS) which was recently announced by ITU Americas Regional Office, to be organized by the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) and hosted by the Government of El Salvador. The Forum will be held in hybrid mode on **16-18 August 2023 in San Salvador, El Salvador,** back-to-back with the ITU Internet Colloquium and New Technologies ITEC 2023.

RDF-AMS will report on the outcomes, and ongoing implementation of the World Telecommunication Development Conference (WTDC-22) held in Kigali, Rwanda in June 2022. Emphasis will be given to the four Regional Initiatives for Americas approved at WTDC-22.

The Annual Regional Development Forum for Americas provides an opportunity for the exchange of views between ITU and decision-makers of ITU Member States and Sector Members as well as other stakeholders in the Americas region. It serves as a platform for an exchange of views on how to achieve meaningful connectivity and sustainable digital transformation in the region. This year's Regional Development Forum will focus on matchmaking between Member States needs, and Partner pledges under the <u>Partner2Connect</u> <u>Digital Coalition</u> that have so far attracted over 750 pledges valued at 30 billion dollars. The aim will be together with partners, to operationalize these pledges and implement across the Americas region impactful projects. New pledges could also be announced on this occasion.

In this context, the ITU Office for Americas is launching a <u>Regional Consultation</u> that presents an opportunity for ITU Member States, Sector Members, and other stakeholders to contribute to ITU's activities at the regional level taking into account the strategic needs of the region and partner offerings/commitments during the period, 2023 – 2025.

Stakeholders (Member States, and Partners) who will attend this RDF'S Partner2Connect roundtables are invited to submit their written contributions to be used as basis for discussions, by 30 July 2023. These may be submitted to:
