
10-parameter assessment criteria for centers



#	Parameter	Purpose
1	Vision and Strategy	Understand the clarity in vision and effective strategies in place to achieve goals.
2	Scope	Gauge the scope and extent of the organization's activities.
3	Type of Center, Purpose and Reach	Assess the potential and purpose of the type of center proposed and its possible reach.
4	Governance System	Gauge the effectiveness and transparency of the input for the governance system to support the center in achieving its objectives.
5	Capabilities & Resources Available	Assess the organization's ability to leverage skills, knowledge, expertise, infrastructure and other resources to deliver on the desired outcomes.
6	Alignment with Strategic Objectives	Evaluate the coherence and alignment of the center's strategy with the strategic objectives of the Alliance.
7	Services Offered	Assess the range, quality and effectiveness of the services provided/proposed by the center.
8	Scale up – Business model	Assess the center's ability and readiness to expand and scale its operations, initiatives, and impact.
9	Level of commitment of Project Initiator	Evaluate the level of involvement, ownership and willingness of the project initiator(s) to invest time, resources and effort towards the success of the center.
10	Regional balance	consideration of equitable distribution of resources and opportunities across different regions.
