Subject: Invitation to the ITU Workshop on the role of Broadcasting in effective Early Warning Dissemination, 21 July 2025, Siem Reap, Cambodia

I am pleased to invite your organization to participate in the workshop on the role of broadcasting in effective Early Warning Dissemination to be conducted on 21 July 2025 in Siem Reap, Cambodia. The workshop is being organized as a pre-event of the 20<sup>th</sup> Asia Media Summit (AMS) 2025 which is organized by the Asia-Pacific Institute for Broadcasting Development (AIBD).

The event will feature discussions on the vital role of broadcasting in Early Warning Systems (EWS), emphasizing its ability to deliver timely and accurate hazard alerts to the public. Furthermore, it will highlight how broadcasting—both traditional and modern—serves as a critical component of EWS, enhancing community preparedness and disaster response.

The sessions will look at how broadcasting can be embedded into best practices of early warning through standardized technologies and explore how ITU-standardized Common Alerting Protocol (CAP) alerts can optimize early warning dissemination across multiple platforms, especially broadcasting whilst the tabletop exercise will help strengthen broadcasters' capacity to rapidly disseminate standardized flood early warnings (CAP alerts) through multi-platform systems while ensuring message clarity, accessibility, and public action.
