Source	Topic	Summary
CRA Qatar	Fixed Broadband by Household	Proposal to make 'fixed broadband by household' a candidate indicator for a future revision of the IDI, dependent on progress made by UN Statistical Commission.
	Traffic Indicators	Noting the use of mobile and fixed traffic indicators, contribution discusses implications of traffic indicators and human development benefits implied by their inclusion in the IDI. No action proposed.
	Percentiles / Goalposts	Proposal to convert mobile and fixed traffic indicators to 95th percentile normalisation to be made based on measured values versus a pre-set cap.

Identify indicators for potential inclusion in the IDI, based on the Candidate Indicators framework (see section 4 of the sub- group's Report of activities 2024).	New indicator: 5G coverage by population  Candidate indicator: Fixed broadband coverage by household  All other indicator proposals as discussed but not adopted  (subject to discussion).
Based on the work achieved above, make a recommendation to EGTI/EGH regarding the revision of the IDI, in line with Resolution 131.	Based on the above, we propose make a recommendation to <b>EGTI/EGH TO REVISE THE IDI</b> , in line with Resolution 131.
After identifying candidate indicators, the subgroup may, time permitting, review additional methodological aspects of the IDI, such as normalization (goalposts) and aggregation.	Subject to discussion.
