Report on progress of the TDAG Working Group on the Declaration

Background

- **Terms of Reference and expected output**

- TDAG-WG-DEC was entrusted the task 'to propose elements and make recommendations to ITU membership for the future draft Declaration' of the World Telecommunication Development Conference 2025 (WTDC-25).
- The output of TDAG-WG-DEC will serve as input for members to consider as they work on the WTDC-25 Declaration in the lead up to and at the conference.

- **Chair and Vice-chairs**

- Chair: Dr Abdulkarim Oloyede from Nigeria
- Vice-chairs: Mr Ahmed Abd El-Aziz from Egypt and Ms Ke Wang from China

- **Meetings**

- TDAG-WG-DEC met on 6 September 2024, 2 December 2024 and 5 March. A final meeting will be held during TDAG-25.
- At the third meeting, the Chair presented a draft proposal for the Declaration and the group provided extensive comments and suggested revisions. A revised draft proposal will be submitted for discussion to the next meeting.
- The Chair of the TDAG Working Group on the Declaration (TDAG-WG-DEC), Mr. Abdulkarim Oloyede (Nigeria), presented a progress report at the Extraordinary meeting of TDAG (23 January) on the group's efforts to prepare a draft Declaration for WTDC-25. TDAG noted with appreciation the report and acknowledged the proposed theme and structure.

- **Coordination with RTOs**

- Regional Telecommunication Organizations have been invited to provide progress reports on their preparations for WTDC-25.

Approach and Focus

- **Key topics ***

- In terms of the key topics to be addressed in the Declaration, the Group emphasised the need to coordinate with the other TDAG working groups, in particular the one on ITU-D Priorities (TDAG-WG-ITUDP)
- Rationale and thinking process informed by the original mapping of topics in the Kigali Declaration and new and emerging topics

- **Proposed Theme ***

- 'Universal, meaningful and affordable connectivity for an inclusive and sustainable digital future'

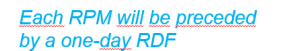
- **Proposed Structure ***

- The Group agreed to retain a structure similar to the Kigali Declaration and be concise, simple and with clear and actionable language, speaking to both the challenges of global digital development and potential solutions
- Four main sections: Introduction, 'We declare,' 'We commit,' and Call to Action

- **Draft proposed text**

- The Chair's draft proposal reflects discussions in TDAG-WG-DEC and TDAG-WG-ITUDP. It was developed from the annotated outline agreed upon by the group, which was based on a mapping of key themes from the Kigali Declaration and insights from recent major international conferences.
- A revised draft proposal will be submitted for discussion to the next meeting of the group.
