INTRODUCTION

The World Telecommunication Development Conference (WTDC-22), held from 6 to 16 June 2022 in Kigali, Rwanda, adopted the Kigali Declaration and the Kigali Action Plan (KAP), which includes 28 Regional Initiatives (RIs)¹.

This information document presents a mapping of projects implemented between 2023 and 2025 and that included activities in support of any the WTDC-22 Regional Initiatives for the CIS Region. The report includes projects implemented at the regional or national level, as well as multi-regional projects that had activities in the region². In this mapping, projects are presented by Region and Regional Initiative, presenting a brief overview of the expected results and achievements for each project. To facilitate accessing information, projects that have contributed to more than one Regional Initiative are presented in each of the RIs to which they contribute³.
