



Guidelines agreed by the CWG-SFP for the development of the new SP framework

Principle	Simplification and clarity	Provide inputs on how to simplify and clarify the strategic framework
Principle	Focus	Provide inputs on (1) how to <u>keep the strategic plan at a high level</u> and (2) identify main themes of work that reinforce synergies across the Sectors
Principle	One ITU	Provide inputs to clarify and strengthen the concept of One ITU in the strategic plan
Component	Vision/Mission	Collect further inputs in view of potentially adjusting the wording of the vision and mission, respectively
Component	Goals	Provide inputs on the possibility and implications of <u>keeping</u> , <u>adjusting or grouping</u> <u>the current goals</u>
Principle	Regional presence	Provide inputs on how to <u>incorporate the role of ITU's regional presence</u> in the strategic plan
Component	ITU results framework	Continue to develop the ITU results framework
Component	Targets	Provide inputs to review the current set of targets
Principle	Linkage with Financial Plan	Consider the following principles: (1) direct <u>linkage between the strategic priorities</u> and the allocation of financial & human resources, and (2) no elements should remain <u>unfunded</u>
Principle	Developments at the UN level	Provide <u>updates on the ongoing discussions at the UN level</u> & inputs to better <u>reflect the role of the ITU within the UN system</u>






