Subject: Applications open for ITU training course on “AI governance in practice: developing secure and innovative frameworks”, Geneva, 14-18 September 2026

I am pleased to invite your organization to participate in the second edition of the flagship International Telecommunication Union (ITU) training course on ‘AI governance in practice: developing secure and innovative frameworks’, to be held at ITU headquarters in **Geneva, Switzerland, from 14 to 18 September 2026**. This comprehensive training programme is organized by the ITU with the financial support of the Global Gateway Initiative of the European Union.

This intermediate-level training course is designed to equip policymakers, regulators and government officials with the essential knowledge and tools to navigate AI governance. It will cover key AI concepts and important topics such as risks, legal frameworks, and ethical models related to AI, focusing on the AI system lifecycle and featuring hands-on activities like sandbox prototyping and policy negotiation. The course includes real-world simulations, case studies, design labs, and scenario analysis. By the end of the training, participants will create a tailored five-year AI governance action plan for their institutions, based on global best practices and rights-based safeguards. Participants will be expected to do some preparatory work online as a requirement to participate in the course.

The training is targeted at policymakers and government officials who are involved in developing, implementing, and influencing AI national governance frameworks. Participation is provided free of charge for selected applicants, including accommodation, most meals, and some extracurricular activities. However, selected participants or their organizations will be responsible for covering their own travel expenses to and from Geneva, Switzerland, as well as any applicable visa application costs.
