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3 Things about Impact Investing


"Impact investments are investments made with the intention to generate positive, measurable social and environmental impact alongside a financial return."

- Financial returns are expected




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Spectrum - Impact Investing


Opportunity: Millennials! Increasing millennial interest in social/environmental values. Over the next 40 years, baby boomers will transfer \$41 Trillion of assets to millennials.



Financing the SDGs

- Investment in sustainable, climate resilient infrastructure is arguably the single best way to achieve the SDGs
- The lion's share of this is needed in developing countries.
- We are currently only meeting around half of the SDG funding requirements. There is a multitrillion-dollar gap every year which the public sector cannot fill by itself.
- \$12 trillion economic opportunity for the private sector over the next 10 to 15 years.


