Anthony is the co-founder of Inclusive Creation, and the creator of the Inclusion Game and the mind behind the 4 fundamental principles of universal design. Anthony works with organizations around the world to put inclusion promises into practice. He's a programmer turned professor turned entrepreneur with just a dash of work as an actor and opera singer thrown in for good measure. He is one of the world's leaders in inclusive innovation and design. He's a motivational speaker on inclusive leadership, a social entrepreneur, and an equality advocate. Among his many accolades, he is proudest to have led a team of first-semester computer science students to win the UN Hack for Health in 2017 and returned in 2019 with a new group of first-semester computer science students to win the Hack for Education. His best paper award from Cambridge University was co-authored with yet another student. He is former people's choice award winner of Norway's Researcher Grand Prix, and he has repeatedly won awards for his prolific achievements as a researcher and innovator. He has published groundbreaking scientific articles on everything from law to journalism, computer science, sociology, political science, engineering, psychology, and education. He has helped launch over 25 companies and non-profits with over half being led by women. He regularly advises and collaborates with EU and UN institutions including the International Telecommunication Union and UN Women.
