Dr Gulati is a professor of technology policy and competition law. A telecom, technology, and competition law expert with over 32 years of experience, Dr Gulati was previously an Indian Civil Services officer and retired voluntarily in 2021. Subsequently, she worked as Senior Adviser on competition law with a law firm and was Head of Public Policy at Google, India, till October 2022. Her Government positions include Advisor (Digital Communications) at the National Institute for Transforming India and Advisor (Head) Merger & Acquisitions at the Competition Commission of India. She has also been Head of Finance in India’s Universal Service Fund.

Her educational qualifications include a BA Honours in Economics from Delhi University, an LLM (Telecom & IT law) from the University of Strathclyde, UK, and a PhD. from the Indian Institute of Technology, Delhi.

Dr Gulati has been an International Telecommunication Union (ITU) expert/resource person since 2010. She was recently Co-rapporteur of the ITU-D Study Group I, Q6/1 (2018-21), dealing with Consumer Protection in the Digital Age.
